

13th AICLST – Guidelines for Authors for Abstract Submission

1. Abstract Preparation Guidelines

1. Authors must submit the abstract **as a separate file** (Word) following the prescribed format.
Abstracts submitted without the proper format – or without complete author and affiliation details – **will be returned** for correction and **not forwarded for review**.
2. The abstract must be written in **clear English**, with a maximum word limit of **250 words**.
3. The abstract should provide:
 - A concise summary of the study or work
 - Key objectives
 - Methods / innovation (where applicable)
 - Major outcomes or expected contributions
 - Significance of the work for the leather sector
4. The *quality and clarity* of the abstract will determine whether the paper is selected for **oral** or **poster** presentation.
5. Authors must clearly mention **the technical session / theme** under which the paper falls (e.g., Sustainability, Leather Technology, Marketing & Innovation, Supply Chain, Circular Economy, etc.)

2. Submission Email IDs

3. Required Structure / Syntax of the Abstract File (Template)

Authors **must use the following format exactly** when submitting their abstract:

Title of Abstract:

Enter the full title of the abstract here

Author(s) Name & Brief Professional Description (2–3 lines):

Full Name of Author 1 – brief professional description (e.g., area of expertise, academic/industry background)

Full Name of Author 2 – brief professional description (if applicable)

Add additional authors as required

Designation & Organization:

Author 1: Designation, Name of Organization/Institution

Author 2: Designation, Name of Organization/Institution (if applicable)

Affiliation to the Organization / Institution (for Presentation):

*Specify the institute/organization under which the paper will be presented
(e.g., University/Research Institute/Company/Department)*

Correspondence Email Address:

Provide the primary corresponding author's email address

Technical Session / Theme:

(Select the most relevant category for your paper, e.g., Sustainability, Leather Technology, Marketing & Innovation, Circular Economy, Supply Chain, Materials Science, etc.)

Body of the Abstract (Maximum 250 words):

Write the abstract here. It should briefly describe:

- *Purpose and objectives of the study/work*
- *Methods, approach or innovation*
- *Key findings or expected outcomes*
- *Contribution or significance to the leather sector*

(Do not exceed 250 words.)

Keywords:

List 4–6 keywords relevant to the paper
